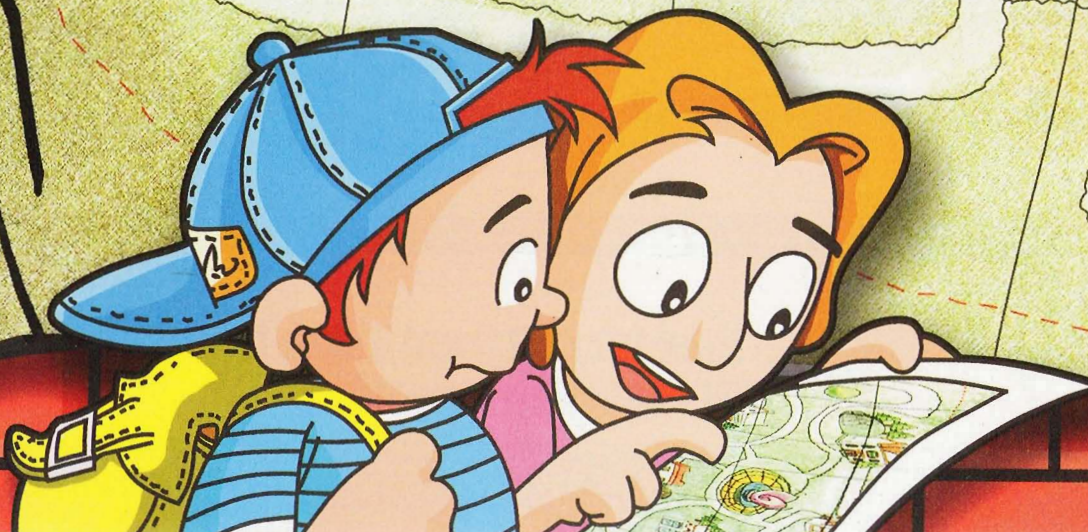

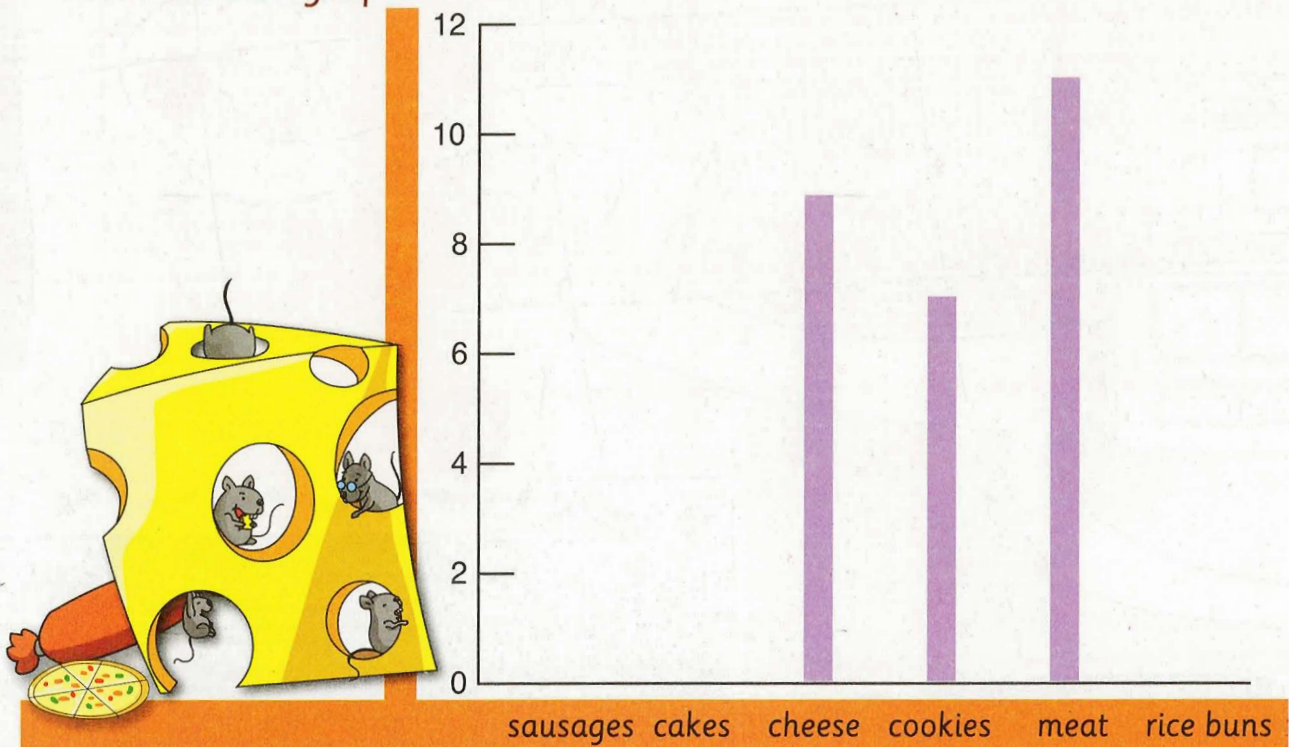

This is a great game to play with your friends, with everyone taking a turn.

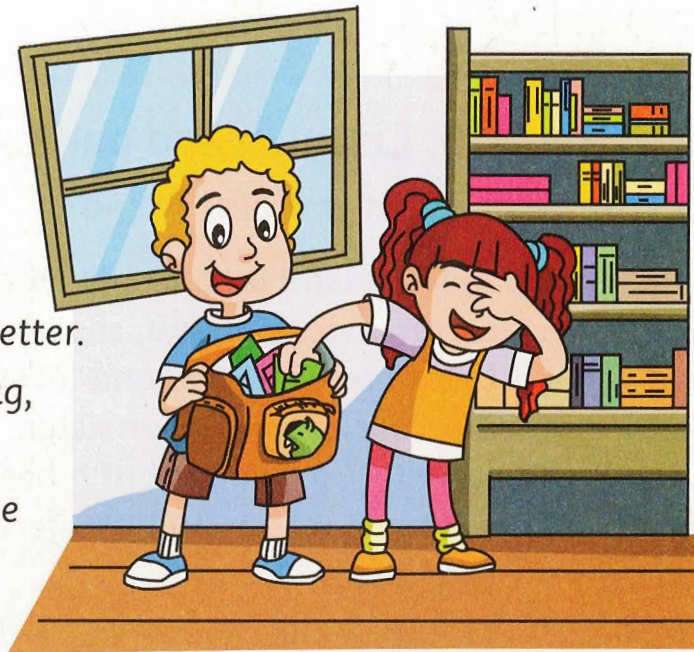
- 1) Put your hand in the bag and pick a letter.
