How to Make a Rainbow

Do you like rainbows? You can make a rainbow **indoors**.



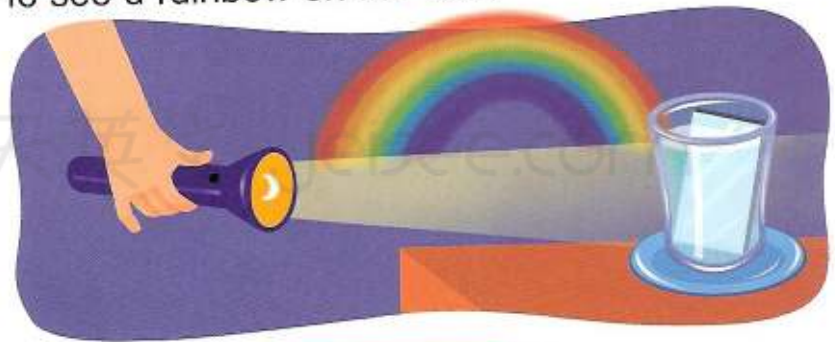
First, put water in a glass.
